

## What to do during a Flood Emergency

### in Bradwell

Action/Trigger	Focus	Local action	Equipment required
Heavy/torrential rainfall forecast.	<b>Control Point</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– primary</li> <li>– contingency</li> </ul>	Local volunteers meet at St Ives Bridge <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Task, deploy and manage volunteers</li> <li>– maintain communications &amp; consider their health &amp; safety</li> </ul>	Keys to control locations
	<b>Vulnerable residents</b> - known by volunteers to have mobility issues.	Warn and aid vulnerable residents to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move valuables upstairs</li> <li>• Raise furniture off ground using buckets/bricks</li> <li>• Ensure safety (warm, medicines accessible)</li> <li>• Turn off electricity to ground floor</li> <li>• Move to safe location if required.</li> </ul>	Gloves Torch Mobile phone/Walkie Talkie Bricks/buckets
High river level	<b>Giving advice to at risk residents</b>	Give general advice to residents <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move cars to higher ground</li> <li>• Put together a flood survival pack</li> <li>• Move valuables upstairs</li> </ul>	Waders Torch Mobile phone
Water threatening to enter properties	<b>Road Closures</b> Required if vehicles produce waves in standing water on B6049 – Church Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contact police/highways</li> <li>• Station volunteers either side of flooding to warn vehicles to proceed slowly</li> </ul>	Cones & signs Hi-Vis jackets Torch Mobile phone
Calls from residents.	<b>Ensure safety of residents &amp; visitors:</b> Consider roads, riverside locations and play areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warn people (esp. children) of dangers of walking/playing in flood waters (disease, open manhole covers, fast flows, deep water) when seen to be doing so.</li> </ul>	
	<b>Information sharing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Feedback situation on ground to Environment Agency Incident Room (or Derbyshire County Council for surface water flooding).</li> <li>• Seek updates on latest river level forecasts/duration of floods.</li> </ul>	Call 0800 80 70 60 & ask to speak to the Flood Duty Officer for Derbyshire

## Bradwell has a group of volunteer Flood Wardens

Local volunteers/flood wardens that could be contacted in an incident.

Consider using other volunteers such as communicators, administrators or minders of vulnerable people during an incident.

**Volunteers must not put their own life at risk.**
