# 102/2009 Planning Application - Newburgh Estates Ltd.

The amended outline Planning Application, NP/DDD/1208/1089, as provided by PDNPA, was made available for viewing prior to the meeting.

The Clerk advised the meeting of the telephone conversation he had had with Mr R Bryan, who said a) that the date for responding to the amended application could be extended until early to mid-September and b) that he did not have a list of the changes.

The Clerk was asked to write to PDNPA to confirm the extended response date and also to obtain from Mr. R Bryan and Mr J Keeley a list of the changes in the application. The letter should also propose a meeting with the council and also remind PDNPA of their promise to hold a village meeting to discuss the amended application.

The council wished to debate the changes only and needed to know what these were.

It was resolved to suspend Standing Orders to allow members of the public to contribute to the debate.

It was emphasised that if property owners affected by the application did not wish to participate in the development, then they should write to PDNPA to inform them.

It was unclear if Newburgh Estates Ltd. had issued notices to these property owners.

It was resolved to re-instate Standing Orders.

A discussion took place regarding a village group conducting a press campaign and recruiting residents with media skills to assist.
