CC-01/2022 Apologies for Absence

CC-02/2021 Running of the Carnival 2022

The theme for the carnival was agreed as "70 years of celebrations".

It was agreed that the charge for stalls should be £20 for 2022

The committee agreed to have a Gin and Prosecco horsebox on the field

It was agreed to ask the CLT to provide a beer tent with Beer, Cider and Wine

Bradwell Ice cream to confirm that they will supply ice pops as they were not available at the last carnival

Road closure permits to be applied for in May

Clerk to book the usual services required as per previous carnivals

It was agreed that no dogs would be allowed on the field on carnival day. Stall holders to be advised that they cannot bring their dogs with them. Additional notices to be placed on all entrances to the field advising dogs are not permitted on the field. It was agreed that a not would be put into the Bradwell News so residents are aware that dogs will not be allowed on the field.

CC-03/2022 – Date of carnival 2023

The committee questioned the changing of the date of the carnival – some years it is on the first Saturday in August, other years it is on the last Saturday in July. The committee have requested the day remains constant as the first Saturday in August
