CC-14/2024 Apologies for Absence

Cllr Downing submitted apologies for reason of holiday.

CC-15/2024 To accept the minutes of the Carnival committee meeting on 15/05/2024 and review any matters arising from the minutes not on Agenda.

It was confirmed that Bradda Dads were running the Friday evening event, there would be a licenced bar, and The Smart Family had agreed to provide the music with their family band. There would also be a disco. Bradda Dads would be using a generator for a fridge, freezer and PA system. There would be two bouncy castles, an ice cream van and Cllr Taylor had booked a pizza oven.

The dads had agreed with CLT that they would use their bar and equipment, but everything would be kept separate. The field would be set up on Thursday evening instead of Friday. The stalls would also be set up for Carnival on the Friday but would not be manned as there weren't enough volunteers.

The clerk confirmed that she had arranged for the chairs to be collected from HVC, and Cllr Cornish would arrange their collection.

The clerk confirmed that everything on the checklist had been done, unfortunately the Morris Dancers were not available, but she had booked The Red Barrows.

Cllr Taylor confirmed that the collection buckets were to be signed out from the queen's tent, and new numbers and labels would need adding.

Dan Plevy reported that unfortunately there would not be a torchlight procession this year as no one had had time to organise it. Committee agreed that this was something we would need to organise earlier next year.

Dan asked if Bradda Dads could order a new marquee for Bradda Dads with the premise of it being available for community use. The clerk suggested that they apply for an S137 grant.

Cllr Cornish reported that there was still a need for marshals, it was agreed to advertise on social media.
